

## NFR MODEL CONTEST RULES, ELIGIBILITY AND AWARDS

Revised, JW 17 November, 2019; all previous versions are obsolete.

### JUDGED MODEL CONTEST RULES

1. All models must be brought to the contest room. They must be properly entered and removed by the entrant as supervised by the contest committee.
2. No entries will be accepted after judging has started. Late models may be exhibited in the Popular Choice Display Area.
3. Suitable space will be allotted for effective judging and viewing. Every reasonable precaution will be taken to safeguard the models.
4. All entries must be made on the official entry forms (901 and 902). Contestants will be given a receipt which must be presented to recover the entry.
5. There is no limit to the number of entries per contestant.
6. First, second and third place ribbons will be awarded in each category on the basis of points earned.
7. The Best-in-Show award will consist of a plaque.

### JUDGED MODEL CONTEST ELIGIBILITY

1. Contestants must be paid-up members of the NMRA.
2. Commercially built models and professional model builders are ineligible.
3. Unmodified, ready-to-run models are ineligible.
4. Models that have won awards in previous NMRA Regional or National contests are ineligible.
5. Entries requiring more than 10 square feet of space and/or weighing more than 100 pounds are ineligible.
